

The Rules For 2013

- Select 6 players who you think will combine for the lowest score in this years Masters.
- The entry with the lowest score from par, using the rules listed to the right, will win.
- The winner receives 50% of the total money. Second and third will receive 30% and 20%, respectively.



- All entries are \$10.00 each.
- You may enter as many times as you would like.

Joan's Rules:

You must select 6 players from the list on page 2.

For the first two days of the tournament the scores for all 6 players will count for your total. For the final two days, only the scores for 4 players will count. If vou have more than four players make the cut, the best 4 scores of the day of your remaining players will be used.

If you select a player who does not start, or drops out, that player will be scored at the highest score of the day.

You must have 4 players make the cut or you are out of the pool.

In case of any ties, the tiebreaker will be your fifth player, then your sixth player, then, if necessary, next tiebreaker will be lowest round of 4 best players, then split money evenly.

If you selected the tournament winner, you will receive a 3 stroke bonus deducted from your score.
